Project Background

As our aim is to engage and develop youth in Indonesia while giving impact to specic issues around us. Project Description

Local Project is an initiative program which provides youth development in four weeks of virtual volunteering in a project which supports Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). It provides youth the experience to create impact in society and introduce them to the concept of leadership development with us. EduStanding is a project that is aware that the poor school environment is a signicant issue in West Kalimantan. This not only about the area hygiene but also other problems like bullying or students hatred toward their teacher. It goes beyond just poor hygiene to encompass issues such as bullying and student hostility towards teachers, besides the gap between teachers and students, there is also a gap between education for typical children and those with special needs, where the implementation of inclusive programs in West Kalimantan is still limited, and there is still a lack of societal awareness regarding the importance of at least understanding sign language. These problems often arise due to minor misunderstandings, educational disparities, and lack of modernization efforts. With many kids in Kalimantan Barat hooked on gadgets and a growing gap between students and teachers, there's a big problem with educational fairness when it comes to our national culture. Gadgets not only stop kids from understanding and valuing their heritage, but they also make it hard for teachers and students to connect. That's why it's really important to do something now to make education fairer and more culturally rich.
